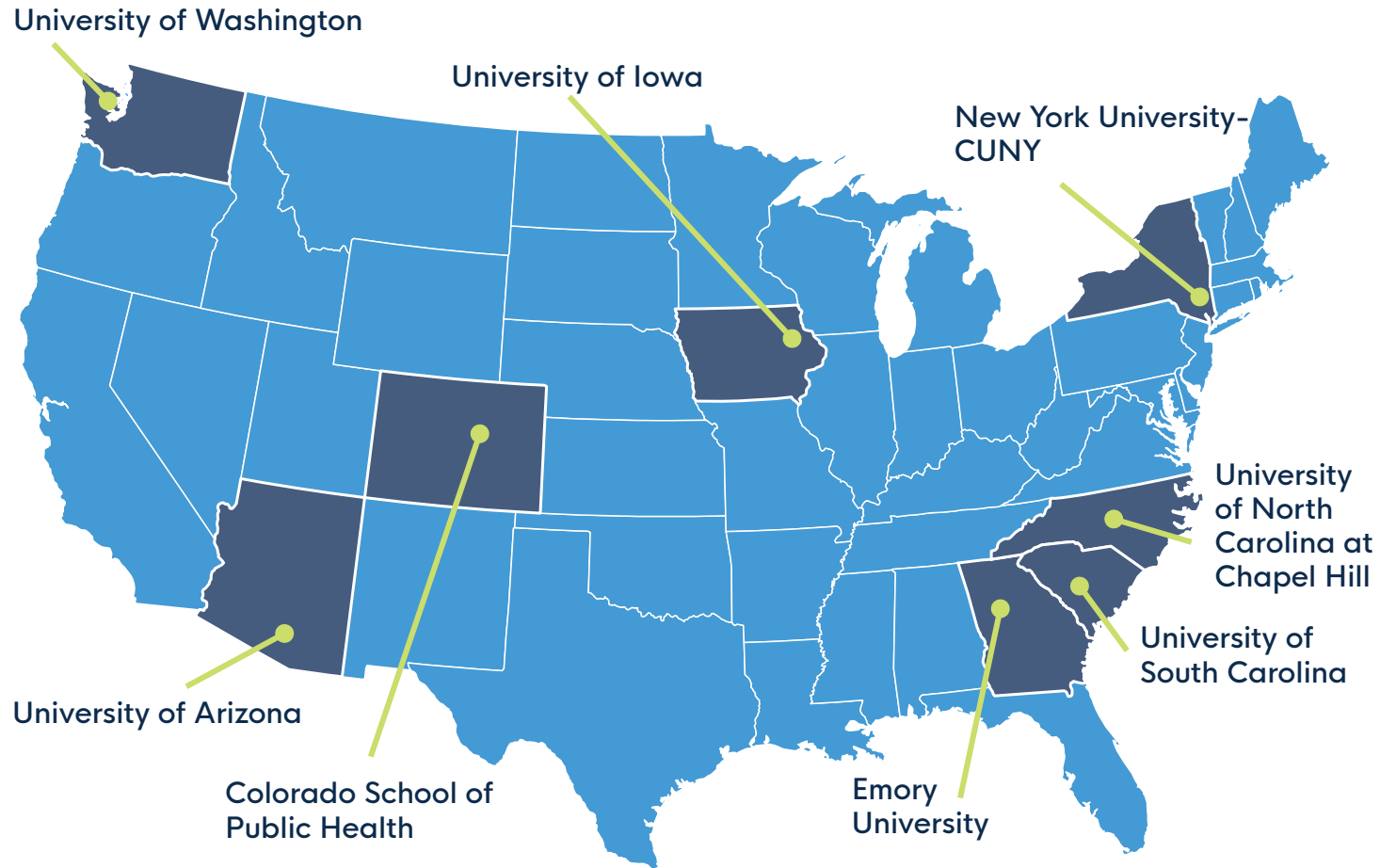
## CPCRN Vision
