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**About:** The CPCRN Health Equity Workgroup (previously *Health Equity & SDOH Interest Group*) advances health equity in cancer prevention & control research and provides the CPCRN with: guiding principles for health and racial equity; tools for measurement and evaluation of health & racial equity principles; case studies intended to serve as examples of the equity principles in action and guidance around implementing them; and technical assistance to support the integration of health and racial equity into research.

## **Planned Products and Deliverables:**

Efforts are divided across three subgroups, each with distinct scopes and proposed deliverables:

- a) Operationalizing Principles via Case Studies:
  - Conduct interviews with key informants from CPCRN Centers, including researchers and federal agency partners to examine how the guiding principles (developed during last reporting period) are operationalized in practice.
  - Incorporate case studies into a web-based case study repository housed on the CPCRN website and featured in ≥3 manuscripts about: health and racial equity principles; CPCRN case studies; and health equity and implementation strategies.
  - Other possible product: checklist to assess the extent to which future CPCRN projects incorporate the nine principles and which gaps need to be addressed.

## b) Measurement & Evaluation:

- Conduct literature review as well as targeted reviews with the support of students and librarians to explore common tools used to measure & evaluate progress in achieving health and racial equity in cancer prevention and control
  - Will develop a manuscript complementary to the CPCRN principles manuscript
- c) Dissemination and Technical Assistance Products & Activities:
  - Develop online repository of case studies, toolkits, literature, measures, and evaluation tools to guide CPCRN members in conducting health equity work.
    - Develop a health equity 'checklist' for CPCRN Centers
    - Develop an annotated bibliography in collaboration with, and building off the work of colleagues at NCI and other academic institutions
  - Advance health equity by providing technical assistance to CPCRN Workgroups and Centers, including working with the Coordinating Center to incorporate an equity lens into the CPCRN Policies and Procedures Network document
