- May vary per center
- Can include:

 - Collaborating Center Reporting (Progress Report)
 - Workgroup Reporting
 - Communications
 - Update center and network members with CPCRN-related news
 - Newsletter submissions
 - And other Project Management responsibilities



PD Role Workgroup Roles and Responsibilities

Role 1: Workgroup Project Director

- Scheduling meetings
- Maintaining and distributing meeting agendas and minutes
- Managing project timelines
- Communicating regularly with Workgroup members
- Strategizing with Workgroup co-chairs
- Drafting the Workgroup progress report

Role 2 (Optional): Scientific Contributor

- Depending on each project director's workload, skillset, or interest
- Development of study instruments, data collection, development of public goods, and literature reviews.
- Project Directors should always be included as authors on products where they have contributed.
